

Mickey & Minnie Halloween Friends

FREE PATTERN



Mickey/Minnie Ghost

Body.

R1- 8sc in MR (8sts)

R2- *inc*x8 (16sts)

R3- *1sc, inc*x8 (24sts)

R4- *3sc, inc*x6 (30sts)

R5-9- (5 rounds) 1sc in each st (30sts)

R10- 11sc, BO, 6sc, BO, 11sc (30sts)

MAKE SURE THAT YOU "POP" OUT THE BOBBLE STITCHES THE RIGHT WAY.

R11-16- (6 rounds) 1sc in each st (30sts)

IF YOU ARE USING SAFETY EYES, YOU CAN PLACE THEM NOW BETWEEN R6-R7, WITH 3-4 VISIBLE STITCHES IN BETWEEN. FOR R17, I RECOMMEND YOU TO PLACE A STITCH MARKER IN THE FIRST LEFTOVER BLO STITCH SO ITS EASIER TO FIND ON R18.

R17- working in FLO of R16, *1sc, 3hdcinc*x15

R18- working in BLO of R16, 1sc in each st (30sts)

R19- *3sc, dec*x6 (24sts)

START STUFFING AND CONTINUE AS YOU GO.

R20- *dec*x12 (12sts)

R21- *dec*x6 (6sts)

MAKE SURE YOU DON'T OVER STUFF SO THAT YOUR GHOST SITS RIGHT.
F/O, CLOSE OPENING AND WEAVE IN ENDS.



Ears (x2).

R1- 7sc in MR (7sts)

R2- *inc*x7 (14sts)

R3-4- (2 rounds) 1sc in each st (14sts)

R5- *1sc, dec, 2sc, dec*x2 (10sts)

F/O AND LEAVE LONG TAIL FOR SEWING

Nose

R1- ch4, starting in second chain from hook, inc, 1sc, 4sc in last ch, 1sc, inc (10sts)

R2- 1sc in each st (10sts)

F/O AND LEAVE LONG TAIL FOR SEWING

Bobble Stitch (BO).

Yarn over & insert your hook into the st, yarn over & pull through, yarn over & pull through 2 loops. You should have 2 loops on your hook.

Yarn over & insert your hook into the st, yarn over & pull through, yarn over & pull through 2 loops. You should have 3 loops on your hook.

Repeat until you have 5 loops on your hook.
Yarn over & pull through all 5 loops.

Mickey Pumpkin

Pumpkin

ORANGE YARN = REGULAR FONT
BROWN YARN = UNDERLINED FONT

R1- 8sc in MR (8sts)

R2- *inc*x8 (16sts)

R3- *1sc, inc*x8 (24sts)

R4- *3sc, inc*x6 (30sts)

R5-12- (8 rounds) 1sc in each st (30sts)

R13- *3sc, dec*x6 (24sts)

START STUFFING AND CONTINUE AS YOU GO. BUT REMEMBER TO STUFF LIGHTLY, THIS WILL MAKE SHAPING THE PUMPKIN EASIER WHEN YOU GET TO THAT STEP.

R14- *1sc, dec*x8 (16sts)

R15- *dec*x8 (8sts)

R16- FLO, 1sc in each st (8sts)

R17-18- (2 rounds) 1sc in each st (8sts)

F/O, CLOSE OPENING BY USING BLO AND WEAVE IN ENDS.



Ears (x2)

R1- 7sc in MR (7sts)

R2- *inc*x7 (14sts)

R3-4- (2 rounds) 1sc in each st (14sts)

R5- *1sc, dec, 2sc, dec*x2 (10sts)

F/O AND LEAVE LONG TAIL FOR SEWING



Leaf

THE FIRST CHAIN THAT YOU CREATE WILL BE YOUR MAIN CHAIN.

ch3, place 1dc into main ch, ch2, place 1slst into 2nd ch from hook, 1dc into main ch, ch3, slst into main ch

F/O AND LEAVE A LONG TAIL.

Assembly

Bow

LEAVE LONG BEGINNING TAIL. WHEN YOU START, THE FIRST CHAIN THAT YOU CREATE WILL BE YOUR MAIN CHAIN.

ch3, place 2dc into main ch, ch3, slst into main ch, ch3, 2dc into main ch, ch3, slst into main ch

F/O AND LEAVE A LONG TAIL. USING THE LONG TAILS, WRAP THEM AROUND THE CENTER OF YOUR BOW TO CREATE THAT CENTER PART OF THE BOW. TIE THEM TOGETHER IN THE BACK. NOW USING THE REMAINING TAIL TO SEW THE BOW ONTO YOUR MINNIE GHOST.



Ghost Ears- Don't stuff. Attach the top of the ears on each side of the head starting between R2 -R3.

Ghost Nose- Stuffing is optional depending on your tension. Attach the top of the nose between R7 -R8 and the bottom between R10 -R11.

Pumpkin- Cut an extra piece of yarn to create the ridges in the side of the pumpkin. I like to use acrylic yarn first so that I can really pull the yarn tight. Then I use the main pumpkin color yarn to cover the acrylic yarn.

Thread the yarn through your darning needle, insert through the center of the bottom of the pumpkin, come out at the top between the stem and the pumpkin color, then go back in the center of the bottom of the pumpkin again. Repeat 3 more times evenly around the pumpkin. Make sure you leave one section in between the ridges a little wider than the others, this will be where you place your felt face on. F/O and weave in your ends.

Pumpkin Ears- Don't stuff. Attach ears on each side of the stem.

Pumpkin Leaf- Use the tails to sew the leaf on to your pumpkin near the stem.
